## Bible Verse

"I call on you, O God, for you will answer me; give ear to me and hear my prayer." Psalm 17:6

Read each phrase of the verse as an echo: One or two people read a phrase and one or two other people repeat it. After reading and repeating several times, turn this paper over. Try to echo the verse several times from memory!



## Get into the Bible

- Read Psalm 23. What reasons to believe that God will help us are found in this psalm? Count them together!
- Read Ephesians 3:12. Because of Jesus, how may we pray, or approach God? What are other words that mean the same as "confidence"?
- Read Hebrews 4:14-16. Jesus makes it possible for us to come to God. What a confidence builder! Take time to thank Jesus for His love.

## Big Idea

I can ask God for what I need and be confident in His love and help.

## Connecting to Jesus

Many people wanted to see Jesus! But two of the people—a woman, and Jairus, whose daughter was very sick—came to Jesus and showed by their actions that they believed He would answer their prayers for help. The way in which Jesus healed the woman and brought Jairus's daughter back to life reminds us of the way in which Jesus helps and saves us. He is the Savior sent by God. We can call on Him, not only for salvation, but also for help every day.
